



# EQUIPMENT OPERATOR TRAINING

## **FORKLIFT OPERATOR TRAINING**

General Industry Safety Order 3668 contains training requirements for powered industrial truck operators. Operators must complete this training before they are permitted to run a powered industrial truck.



## **AERIAL BOOMLIFT OPERATOR TRAINING**

Each employee who performs work while on an Aerial lift must receive training on the OSHA-required subject matter (29 CFR 1926.452(w)). This will better enable them to recognize the hazards associated with the equipment being used and to understand the procedures to control or minimize those hazards.



## **SCISSOR LIFT OPERATOR TRAINING**

Each employee who performs work while on an Aerial or Mobile scaffold lift must receive training on the OSHA-required subject matter (29 CFR 1926.452(w)). This will better enable them to recognize the hazards associated with the equipment being used and to understand the procedures to control or minimize those hazards.



## **Training Details**

- \* Each training includes pre-class self-study (1-2 hours), classroom instruction (2.5 hours), equipment inspections (30 minutes) and operator practice and performance evaluations (2 hours)
- \* Conducted on-site with district-owned or rented equipment
- \* Training conducted by an IVES-certified, CCCSIG Instructor
- \* Operator re-evaluation required every three years (reminder emails sent in advance to supervisors)
- \* Must have a minimum of 2 attendees; maximum of 5
