Monitors campuses for unauthorized people or activities. Reports situations needing intervention to supervisor or school administration. Identifies and documents/logs location and type of vandalism and notifies appropriate personnel (school district, police, etc.) for action. May take pictures of the graffiti or vandalism damage, assist with the completion of police reports, Maintenance department work orders, etc. as appropriate. Acts a liaison between site of the vandalism (administrative personnel, etc.) and Maintenance Department. May remove or paint over small areas of graffiti using quart can and brush or spray paint can as directed.

Ensures no inappropriate behavior occurs and that safety rules are followed. May interact with child needing extra attention. Gives praise and attention as needed. Ensures seat belts are buckled before bus leaves stop. Alerts driver if student demonstrates potential for danger to self or others. May operated lift on wheelchair accessible vans/buses.
